## ABOUT PGP OPERATING, LLC

PGP Operating, LLC is a producer of natural gas and other hydrocarbons with operations in Alabama. Headquartered in Kennesaw, Georgia, PGP Operating has coalbed methane operations in Jefferson & Tuscaloosa counties. These operations include several hundred miles of underground pipelines that are used for transportation of natural gas (methane) to a sales point.

## WHAT DOES PGP OPERATING, LLC DO IF A LEAK OCCURS?

To prepare for the event of a leak, PGP Operating, LLC communicates, meets with and trains local emergency responders, stockholders and excavators. Upon the notification of an incident or leak the pipeline company will immediately dispatch trained personnel to isolate and repair leaks.

Pipeline operators and emergency responders are trained to protect life, property and facilities in the case of an emergency.

Pipeline operators will also take steps to minimize the amount of product that leaks out and to isolate the pipeline emergency.

## MAINTAINING SAFETY AND INTEGRITY OF PIPELINES

PGP Operating, LLC invests time and capital maintaining the quality and integrity of their pipeline systems. The pipelines are monitored utilizing operator qualified personnel to identify potential dangers and notify management if there is a possibility of a leak or abnormal condition.
