

SUNOCO ANDREWS AFB TERMINAL

Sunoco operates a pipeline system consisting of three functional units, the Anacostia Pier facility, the pipeline and the Andrews AFB terminal. Jet Fuel (Jet-A) is delivered by barge to the Anacostia Pier in southeast Washington, D.C. The pipeline is eight inches in diameter and runs for over ten miles from the pipeline pump adjacent to the Anacostia Pier on the U.S. Naval Reservation in SE Washington, D.C. to Andrews AFB, MD terminal. The Andrews AFB terminal consists of three aboveground storage tanks with 72,000 barrels of storage and ancillary equipment required to support the Jet Fuel receipt and disbursement to the Air Force.

Sunoco is the largest independent fuel distributor in the country that also owns and operates 3 transmix processing facilities along with 23 refined product terminal facilities. Sunoco's operations also include transportation assets to support the distribution of motor fuel to approximately 10,000 convenience stores, independent dealers, commercial customers and distributors located in more than 30 states, including Hawaii. Sunoco LP's general partner is owned by Energy Transfer.
