The City of Cuba owns and operates a natural gas distribution system that has 1,309 customers active at this time. Our natural gas system started in 1993. We are connected to MOGAS Pipeline for the transportation to our Meter Station. The City of Cuba has a MAOP of 60 psi, which we are currently at 36 psi in our distribution system. The City currently maintains 66 miles of mains and services that is an all plastic system.

SAFETY AND PUBLIC AWARENESS

The City of Cuba natural gas system is committed to operating our system in the most reliable and safest manner possible. We are under the regulatory oversight of the office of Pipeline of Safety and the US Department of Transportation and Missouri Public Service Commission.

The City of Cuba does natural gas inspections on a regular basis to ensure the safety of citizens of Cuba and surrounding area. We have emergency preparedness plans in place in case of an emergency. Also, we have natural gas valves marked and tools to stop the flow of natural gas in case of an emergency.
