INTEGRITY MANAGEMENT PLAN OVERVIEW

Ensuring the integrity of our pipelines helps us to successfully meet our goal of protecting employees, customers, contractors, the public, and environment. The HEP Integrity Management Program assists us in preventing leaks and spills, determining pipelines that could affect High Consequence Areas (HCA's) i.e.

populated areas, commercially navigable water-ways and areas that are usually sensitive to potential environmental issues, and assessing risks and identifying actions to mitigate such risks. Aware of the importance of routine maintenance, we inspect our pipelines regularly using state of the art inspection equipment from third party suppliers.

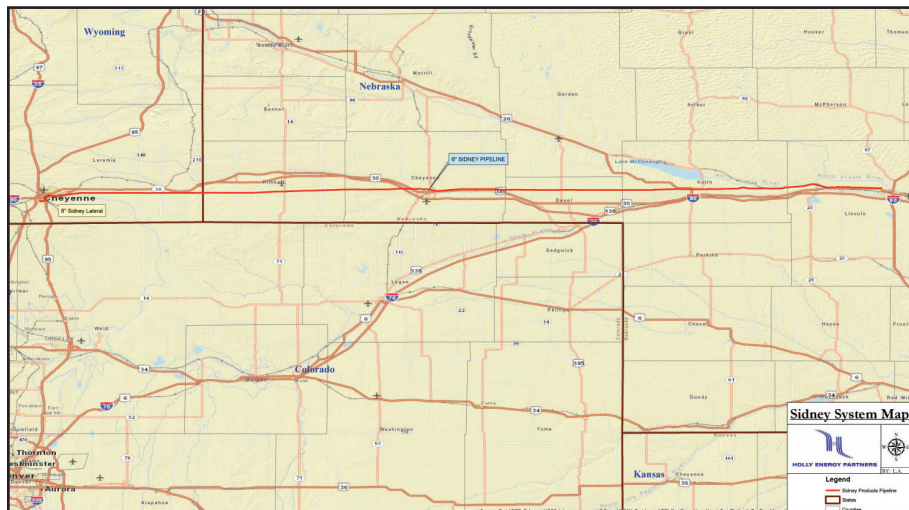
ONE-CALL AND 8-1-1 SUPPORT

HEP is a member of One-Call in each state where it operates. We ensure the management of all one-call tickets according to each state's governing laws. We encourage the use of 8-1-1 to all excavators in order to promote safe digging practices.

In the event of an emergency, HEP will immediately dispatch personnel to the incident site to work with emergency responders and provide information to public safety officials and the public. HEP personnel, after evaluating the situation, will take all necessary operating actions, such as closing and opening valves, to minimize the impact of the leak and control the release from the pipeline.

HEP PIPELINE STATE SPECIFIC INFORMATION

- HEP operates and maintains approximately 170 miles of pipeline in Nebraska and 43 miles of pipeline in Wyoming.
- Diameter of pipelines in system range from 6" – 8".
