INCIDENT ACTION PLAN (EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN)

1. Confirm or determine that an emergency exists. Consider a customer leak an emergency until classified at the scene.
2. Make safe by taking proper and immediate steps to ensure safety to the public and employees. These steps include:
 - a. Establish a restricted zone around incident site to restrict entry to authorized personnel only.
 - b. Evacuate unauthorized persons from restricted zone.
 - c. Eliminate all sources of ignition.
 - d. Check for gas accumulation in nearby buildings.
 - e. If necessary, take steps to promptly stop the flow of gas and shut off gas to buildings in restricted zone.
3. When a public official (police or fire) is on the scene, report your presence to the official in charge.

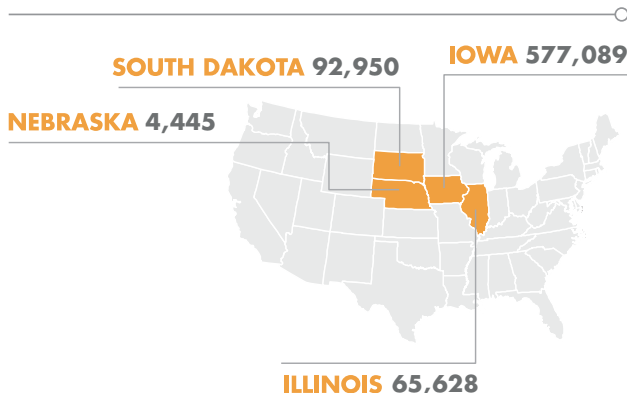
