**WHO IS KINDER MORGAN  
PRODUCT PIPELINES**

Kinder Morgan is the largest independent transporter of petroleum products in North America, transporting approximately 2.1 million barrels per day. The great majority of these products are transported through our Products Pipelines business, which moves gasoline, jet fuel, diesel, natural gas liquids and condensate through about 9,000 miles of pipelines. We also have approximately 60 liquids terminals in this business segment that store fuels and offer blending services for ethanol and biofuels.

**PIPELINES IN YOUR COMMUNITY**

Understanding where pipelines are located, potential hazards and how to identify and respond to a potential leak will keep your family, your employees and your community safe.

Underground pipelines are everywhere. More than two million miles of pipelines crisscross the United States safely transporting natural gas, gasoline and other products every day. According to the National Transportation Safety Board, pipelines are the safest mode of fuel transportation, both for the public and the environment.

Kinder Morgan is one of the largest pipeline transportation companies in the United States and operates in almost every state. Our pipelines transport natural gas, gasoline, crude oil, CO2 and other products. We monitor our operations 24-hours a day, every day. We ensure public safety and safe pipeline operations through employee training, regular testing, right-of-way aerial and foot patrols and adherence to our comprehensive Integrity Management plan and procedures.

**WHAT ARE THE SIGNS OF A  
PRODUCT LEAK?**

- Dead vegetation, liquid on the ground near the pipeline, dirt being blown into the air, fire, dense white cloud or fog, or frozen ground near the pipeline.
- Hissing or roaring sound
- Strong petroleum scent, mild fragrant odor (Ethanol), or other pungent odor such as sulfur (rotten eggs or garlic-like); Natural Gas may also be odorless from 4" – 16".

**IF YOU SUSPECT A LEAK OR A  
LEAK OCCURS:**

- Leave the area immediately in an upwind direction and warn others to stay away.
- If near a school, evacuate students and staff from the area immediately as outlined in your emergency response plan.
- Do not light a match, start an engine, use a telephone or cell phone or turn on/off any electrical appliances, and avoid potential ignition sources which may cause an explosion or fire.
- Once you are a safe distance away from the potential leak use a telephone or cell phone to call 911 and Kinder Morgan.
- Do not drive into an area where you suspect a leak, and do not touch or operate pipeline valves.
- Avoid making contact with escaping liquids or vapors as potential hazards may include eye, skin and respiratory irritation and the product may be highly flammable.

**PIPELINE MARKERS**

Kinder Morgan's pipeline markers, like those below, are placed at intervals along the pipeline route, at road and railroad crossings and at all aboveground facilities. These signs identify the general area but not the exact location of the pipeline. They specify the type of product transported, the operator's name and an emergency contact number.
