HOW TO RESPOND TO AND REPORT A PIPELINE EMERGENCY:

- SECURE the area around the leak to a safe distance
- CONTACT the pipeline operator and 911 as soon as possible
- ESTABLISH a command center

- CONTROL IGNITION SOURCES. If the pipeline leak is not burning, take steps to prevent any open flame or other potential source of ignition, such as an electrical switch, vehicle ignition, light a match, etc
- DO NOT use a cell phone or two-way radio near the suspected emergency area
- DO NOT attempt to put out natural gas or liquids fires. If burning, control secondary fires
- DO NOT operate any pipeline valves or equipment
