Pin Oak Midstream LLC is wholly owned by Pin Oak Energy Partners, LLC based in Akron, Ohio. Pin Oak Midstream, LLC, operates over 1,000 miles of midstream pipelines in Erie, Crawford, Mercer, and Lawrence Counties in Pennsylvania as well as Columbiana, Trumbull and Washington Counties in Ohio with existing volumes transported for delivery into the interconnects with Tennessee Gas Pipeline, National Fuel, and Blue Racer Midstream. These pipeline systems gather gas for Pin Oak Energy Partners as well as other 3rd party conventional and Marcellus producers.

Pin Oak Midstream LLC interconnects provide producers with access to major interstate pipelines serving the New England, the Northeast, Mid-Atlantic and Canadian Markets.

The system's size, segmentation and bi-directional flow make it ideal for producers looking to prove out acreage with initial production volumes.

WHAT DOES PIN OAK MIDSTREAM LLC DO IF A LEAK OCCURS?

Our pipeline is a safe, reliable and efficient pipeline for transporting natural gas. As part of our commitment to ensure safety and operational efficiency, regular surface patrols are conducted to identify leaks and other factors that might affect the pipeline's operation.



While strict engineering standards have been followed in the design, testing, installation and maintenance of our pipeline, outside forces and adverse soil conditions can cause damage allowing gas to escape. Natural gas cannot be seen, nor can it be smelled unless treated with an odorant. To improve safety, we add a harmless chemical giving the gas a distinctive odor of 'rotten eggs'. This increases everyone's ability to detect even the smallest gas leak should one occur. We ask for your help in identifying possible gas leaks and reporting any activity on or near our rights-of-way which might cause damage to our pipeline.

Additionally, we will:

1. Shut down the pipeline and isolate the problem
2. Identify hazards
3. Excavate and repair the damaged pipeline
