The above Panther entities operate pipelines that gather natural gas or crude oil and perform related functions associated with such operations. Panther currently operates onshore and offshore oil and gas pipeline systems in Texas.

WHAT DOES PANTHER DO IF A LEAK OCCURS?

To prepare for the event of a leak, Panther communicates with local emergency responders as required. Upon the notification of an incident or leak, the pipeline company will immediately dispatch trained personnel to assist emergency responders. Pipeline operators and emergency responders are trained to protect life, environment and facilities in the case of an emergency. Panther will also take steps to minimize the amount of product that is released, and to isolate the pipeline emergency.

MAINTAINING SAFETY AND INTEGRITY OF PIPELINES

Panther maintains its pipeline systems and monitors the pipelines frequently as required. Panther utilizes aerial surveillance and/or on-ground observers to identify potential dangers. Panther personnel are notified if there is a possibility of a leak. Over pressure protection is in place as required to protect the pipelines from excessive pressure.

PUBLIC AWARENESS

All members of the communities where we operate should know the location of our pipelines, be aware of what to do in an emergency, and avoid damaging pipelines from excavation.

PIPELINE MARKERS

Markers are placed along pipeline routes to indicate general pipeline locations along rights-of-way and at public road, rail and water crossings. These markers display the product being transported, the pipeline operator name, and an emergency telephone number.

PRODUCTS TRANSPORTED IN YOUR AREA

PRODUCT	LEAK TYPE	VAPORS
HAZARDOUS LIQUIDS SUCH AS: CRUDE OIL	Liquid	Initially heavier than air and spread along ground and collect in low or confined areas. Vapors may travel to source of ignition and flash back. Explosion hazards indoors, outdoors or in sewers.
HEALTH HAZARDS	Inhalation or contact with material may irritate or burn skin and eyes. Fire may produce irritating, corrosive and/or toxic gases. Vapors may cause dizziness or suffocation. Runoff from fire control or dilution water may cause pollution.	
NATURAL GAS	Gas	Lighter than air and will generally rise and dissipate. May gather in a confined space and travel to a source of ignition.
HEALTH HAZARDS	Will be easily ignited by heat, sparks or flames and will form explosive mixtures with air. Vapors may cause dizziness or asphyxiation without warning and may be toxic if inhaled at high concentrations. Contact with gas or liquefied gas may cause burns, severe injury and/or frostbite.
