BASA Resources, Inc. personnel and emergency responders are trained to protect life, property and facilities in the case of an emergency. BASA Resources, Inc. personnel will take steps to minimize the amount that leaks out and to minimize the impact to the surrounding community.

MAINTAINING SAFETY AND INTEGRITY OF PIPELINES

BASA Resources, Inc. invests significant time and capital maintaining the quality and integrity of their systems. BASA Resources, Inc. also utilizes ground and/ or aerial surveillance patrolling to identify potential dangers. Field personnel are immediately notified if there is a possibility of a leak. System valves can be utilized to isolate a leak.

Product: Natural Gas County: Van Zandt Leak Type: Gas

Vapors: Lighter than air and will generally rise and dissipate. May gather in a confined space and travel to a

source of ignition.

Health Hazards: Will be easily ignited by heat, sparks or flames and will form explosive mixtures with air. Vapors may cause dizziness or asphyxiation without warning and may be toxic if inhaled at high concentrations. Contact with gas or liquefied gas may cause burns, severe injury and/or frostbite.

Product: Crude oil County: Rusk Leak Type: Liquid

Vapors: Initially heavier than air and spread along ground and collect in low or confined areas. Vapors may travel to source of ignition and flash back. Explosion hazards indoors, outdoors or in sewers.

Health Hazards: Inhalation or contact with material may irritate or burn skin and eyes. Fire may produce irritating, corrosive and/or toxic gases. Vapors may cause dizziness or suffocation. Runoff from fire control or dilution water may cause pollution.
