WHAT DOES COWBOY PIPELINE OPERATORS LLC/KURARAY DO IF A LEAK OCCURS?

To prepare for the event of a leak, pipeline companies regularly communicate, plan and train with local emergency responders. Upon the notification of an incident or leak the pipeline company will immediately dispatch trained personnel to assist emergency responders.

Pipeline operators and emergency responders are trained to protect life, property and facilities in the case of an emergency. Pipeline operators will also take steps to minimize the amount of product that leaks out and to isolate the pipeline emergency.

MAINTAINING SAFETY AND INTEGRITY OF PIPELINES

Cowboy Pipeline Operators LLC/ Kuraray invests significant time and capital maintaining the quality and integrity of their pipeline systems and utilizes aerial surveillance and/or onground observers to identify potential dangers. Most active pipelines are monitored 24 hours a day via manned control centers where personnel continually monitor the pipeline system and assess changes in pressure and flow and notify field personnel if there is a possibility of a leak. Automatic shut-off valves are sometimes utilized to isolate a leak. Hazardous liquid pipeline operators have developed supplemental hazard and assessment programs known as Integrity Management Programs (IMPs).
