**DAMAGE PREVENTION MEASURES**

There are automatic shutdown valves along the various pipeline systems that are actuated by Nettleton, TX SCADA control. Additionally, there are numerous check valves and mainline block valves located along the line to further isolate strategic sections of the line. SCADA system monitors the East Texas Pipeline System.

**OUR REACTIONS DURING AN INCIDENT**

Operators in the Nettleton, TX will shut down and isolate the East Texas Pipeline System immediately upon any indication of abnormal activity or re-sponse on the system. Once an actual incident location has been determined (either by on-the-ground or air recon-naissance) trained Delek response personnel will be on sight in less than one hour, with response equipment. Emergency response contractors (SWS Environmental, Garner Environmental) and equipment will respond within two to three hours anywhere on the West Texas System.
