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## OVERVIEW

Gulf Crossing Pipeline Company LLC (“Gulf Crossing”) is an interstate natural gas pipeline that provides takeaway capacity from the Barnett Shale in Texas and the Caney/Woodford Shale in Oklahoma. It begins near Sherman, Texas extending to the Perryville, Louisiana area.

## PIPELINE FACILITIES

The Gulf Crossing system is composed of approximately 360 miles of pipeline having a peak-day delivery capacity of approximately 1.7 billion cubic feet per day.
