Johnson County Power, LLC - A 258 MW gas/diesel fired 1-on-1 combined cycle plant. Pipelines include (Atmos) 12" X 0.8 miles; and (ET) 16" X 1.6 miles (both pipelines on the northern side of Cleburne).

WHAT DOES JOHNSON COUNTY POWER. LLC DO IF A LEAK OCCURS?

To prepare for the event of a leak, pipeline companies regularly communicate, plan and train with local emergency responders. Upon the notification of an incident or leak the pipeline company will immediately dispatch trained personnel to assist emergency responders.

Pipeline operators and emergency responders are trained to protect life, property and facilities in the case of an emergency.

Pipeline operators will also take steps to minimize the amount of product that leaks out and to isolate the pipeline emergency.



MAINTAINING SAFETY AND INTEGRITY OF PIPELINES

Johnson County Power, LLC invests significant time and capital maintaining the quality and integrity of their pipeline systems. They notify field personnel if there is a possibility of a leak. Shut-off valves are utilized to isolate a leak.
