COMMITMENT

LBC Houston, L.P. is committed to the protection of the public and the environment through the safe operation and maintenance of its pipeline systems. LBC'S qualified personnel are trained in emergency response activities and regularly participate in drills and exercises reflecting various types of response levels, emergency scenarios, topographic terrain and environmental sensitivities.

LBC Houston, L. P. has committed the necessary resources to fully prepare and implement its emergency response plans and has obtained through contract the necessary private personnel and equipment to respond, to the maximum extent practicable, to a discharge or substantial threat of such a discharge. Additionally, LBC is a member of Channel Industries Mutual Aid (CIMA), which provides an exceptional response capability and real world expertise.

COMMUNICATIONS

LBC utilizes its 24-hour Operations Control Center (1-281-291-3419) as a hub of communications in emergency response situations. The Control Center has a vast catalog of resources and capabilities. On-site communications are conducted using cellular telephones, portable Motorola Radios and/or land-line telephone systems from Company facilities and offices.

INCIDENT COMMAND SYSTEM

LBC utilizes an expandable Incident Command System. Depending upon the size and complexity of an incident, additional Company or contract personnel may be added as needed. Additional federal, state or local agencies may be integrated into the Incident Command System by utilizing a Unified Command Structure.

SPILL RESPONSE EQUIPMENT

LBC maintains emergency response trailers and equipment at the facility. Trailers contain spill boom (of various types, sizes and lengths as needed in different areas), sorbent materials, boats, motors, hand tools, power tools, pumps, hoses, personal protective equipment, first aid and miscellaneous supplies. Additionally, contract responders will provide additional equipment and manpower, and the full capabilities of CIMA are available as needed.

RESPONSE CONTRACTORS

Spill & Release Response Organization under contract is OIL Mop LLC. Additionally CIMA can bring to bear a large response capability, with regard to either fires or releases. These Response Organizations can be relied upon for an appropriate level of response with spill response equipment and trained personnel.
