GULF COAST ONSHORE (GOM) EMERGENCY RESPONSE CAPABILITIES COMMITMENT

Pioneer Natural Resources is committed to the protection of the public and the environment through the safe operation and maintenance of its pipeline systems.

Pioneer's qualified personnel are trained in emergency response activities and regularly participate in exercises reflecting various types of response levels and emergency scenarios.

Pioneer Natural Resources has committed the necessary resources to fully prepare and implement its emergency response plans and has obtained through contract the necessary equipment to respond, to the maximum extent practicable, to a "worst case" discharge or substantial threat of such discharge.

COMMUNICATIONS

Pioneer Natural Resources utilizes a 24-hour Remote Operations Hub (1-866-475-6174). The Remote Operations Hub maintains a Pioneer Natural Resources Contingency Plan which contains the proper personnel to contact in case of an emergency. On-site communications are conducted using cellular phone, and/or land-line telephone systems from Company facilities and offices.

INCIDENT COMMAND SYSTEM

Pioneer Natural Resources maintains two (2) Safe Briefing Areas. Depending upon the size and complexity of an incident, additional Company or contract personnel may be added as needed. All Pioneer Natural Resources employees maintain a Contingency Plan Manual in their vehicles. Additional Safe Command Areas may be established as needed.

RESPONSE EQUIPMENT

All Pioneer Natural Resources personnel maintain 30 minute breathing air equipment, first aid kits, dry chemical fire extinguishers, and personal protective equip-

ment in their vehicles. Pioneer Natural Resources also maintains absorbent material, hand tools and power tools.

SPILL CONTRACTORS

E-Tech Environmental located in Midland, Texas a Certified Oil Response Organization that can be relied upon by Pioneer Natural Resources for an appropriate level of response with spill response equipment and trained personnel.
