REP Kansas Gathering, LLC (“REP”) operates a natural gas pipeline gathering system in Montgomery and Wilson counties. Our goal is to provide for the clean and safe transportation of gas through our pipeline gathering system. The purpose of this brochure is to provide general awareness of our pipeline gathering system, and to demonstrate our desire to protect the public and the environment.

COMMITMENT TO SAFETY, HEALTH & ENVIRONMENT

REP works hard to maintain the integrity of our pipeline gathering system and keep it safe from threats of all kinds. We stay in contact with industry and government to monitor potential threats and to keep apprised of current regulations that guide our industry. We regularly patrol our gathering lines and have field personnel living in close proximity of our operations.



HOW CAN PIPELINE DAMAGE BE PREVENTED?

Third party damage is the number one cause of pipeline damage and pipeline related injuries.

We participate in the Kansas One-call program and we strongly encourage those who are going to dig near the pipeline gathering system to contact the 811 “Call before you dig” hotline. This hotline allows REP and utility companies the opportunity to identify the general location of their underground facilities before digging begins. Failure to contact this number before you dig near the pipeline gathering system could result in serious injury or even death.

Pipeline markers have also been installed as required and provide important information such as how to contact us in an emergency. An example of one is located in this informational sheet.

You can assist us in maintaining public safety, and in protecting your family and neighbors, by being observant of your surroundings. If you observe unusual or suspicious activities or events, please call us at one of the numbers listed in this brochure.

HOW CAN I IDENTIFY A NATURAL GAS LEAK OR EMERGENCY?

A leak can be detected by:

- a hissing, whistling or roaring sound.
- soil being blown into the air.
- bubbles rising to the surface of water or water being blown into the air at a pond, creek or river.
- the vegetation over or near the pipeline gathering system appears dead or dying.

Changes may occur. Contact the operator to discuss their pipeline systems and areas of operation.

- fire coming from the ground or burning above the ground.
- a dry spot along a pipeline system right-of-way in a field with moist soil.

WHAT SHOULD I DO AFTER IDENTIFYING A NATURAL GAS LEAK?

- Move to a safe location;
- Immediately call local emergency responders at 911 and REP Kansas Gathering, LLC at 1-877-282-1717;
- Do not strike a match, use cell phones or telephones, operate engines and motors, or switch on/off appliances, lights, or even a flashlight in the area where you smell gas. These items can produce sparks that might ignite the gas and cause an explosion.
