Williams is one of North America's largest natural gas gatherers and processors, dedicated to becoming the most reliable midstream service provider in the industry. We are focused on running largescale assets and running them well.

The Bluestem Pipeline is a 189.2 mile-long, 16-inch diameter Natural Gas Liquid (NGL) pipeline in Kansas and Oklahoma. The Bluestem system is designed to initially transport 110,000 BPD with an ultimate planned design flow rate of 225,000 BPD of Y- Grade NGL. The primary source of the NGL flowing into Conway is from the existing Overland Pass Pipeline (OPPL) system. The OPPL currently transports NGL from southern Wyoming and Northern Colorado into salt cavern storage at the Mid-Continent Fractionation and Storage facility. Bluestem will receive NGL from

storage at Conway and transport it south for delivery to Targa Resources at Kingfisher, OK.

Williams, through its subsidiaries, finds, produces, gathers, processes, and transports natural gas. Williams' operations are concentrated in the Pacific Northwest, Rocky Mountains, Gulf Coast and Eastern Seaboard. More information is available at <http://www.williams.com>.
