**INCIDENT ACTION PLAN**

**(Emergency Response Plan):**

APL practices the National Incident Management System (NIMS) and will integrate into the Incident Command System (ICS) in an emergency.

- Ensure Life Safety First, protect environment and property next.
- Isolate area and deny entry
- Establish minimum 1/2 mile exclusion
- Determine if atmosphere is safe
- Evacuate if necessary and safe
- Notify Alliance Pipeline
- Safely Control ignition sources
- If ignited, allow to self-extinguish
- Contain or control secondary fires

**PIPELINE UNIQUE CHARACTERISTICS**

- Un-odorized
- 1,935 psig – Operating Pressure
- 36" Steel Pipe
- .622" Pipe thickness (thicker under roadways and rivers)
- Compressor Stations – Located every 120 miles
- Automated Block Valves – located every 20 miles
- High Energy Natural Gas
  - Methane
  - Propane
  - Butane
  - Ethane
  - Pentane

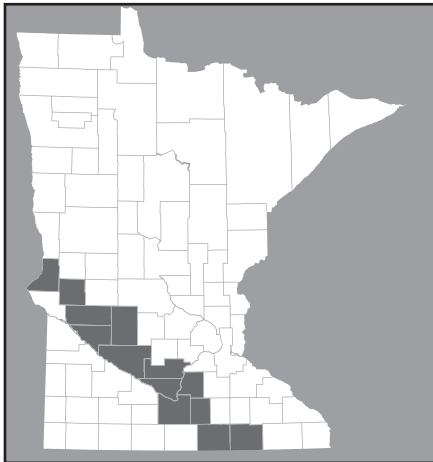
