



OPERATOR OVERVIEW

The New York Mills Municipal Gas System is owned and operated by the City of New York Mills in Otter Tail County, Minnesota that receives natural gas from ONEOK – Viking Gas Transmission an interstate transmission pipeline. From a regulator and odorizer station we provide service to approximately 600 residential, commercial, and industrial customers primarily within the city limits of New York Mills and extend to adjacent Newton Township businesses and residents. The New York Mills Gas System initiated operations in the 1960's.

COMMITMENT TO SAFETY, HEALTH & ENVIRONMENT

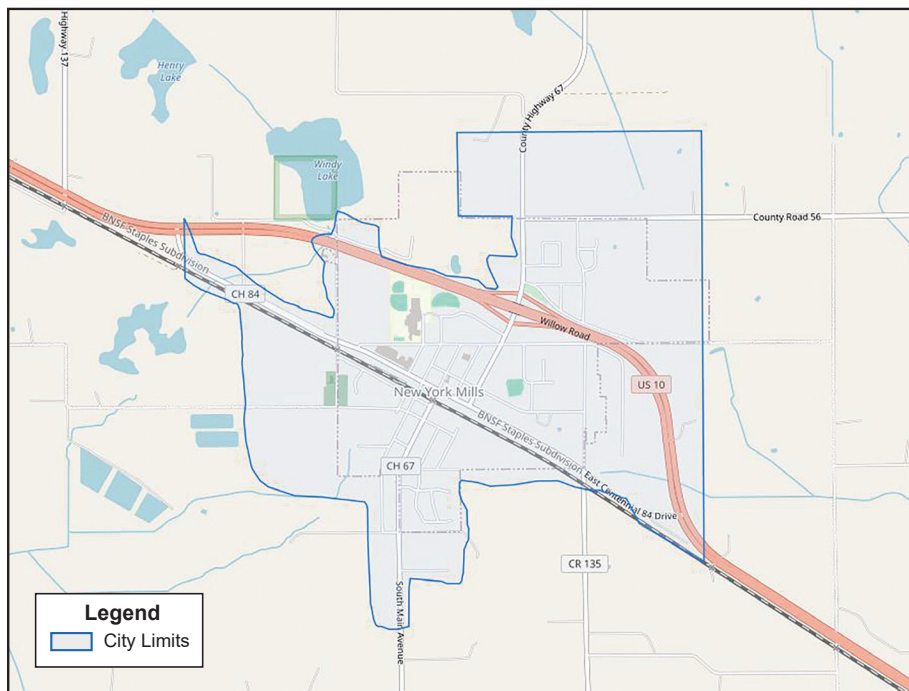
The New York Mills Municipal Gas System conducts a multitude of monthly, quarterly and annual surveys to maintain a safe and reliable natural gas utility. We inspect right-of-ways where natural gas piping is installed and maintain pipeline markers at high consequence areas, highways and railway crossings.

The New York Mills Municipal Gas System is a member of Minnesota's Gopher State One Call (GSOC) program and is responsible for marking all buried natural gas facilities prior to excavation or digging projects when locate tickets are called in by the public, contractors, and others by calling 1-800-262-1166 or 811. We are also a sponsor of the West Central Minnesota Call Before You Dig Damage Prevention Meeting which is held annually to assist GSOC and the Common Ground Alliance (CGA) reach area contractors and stakeholders to educate them on the important message of "Calling before you dig".

MINNESOTA COUNTIES OF OPERATION:

Otter Trail

Changes may occur. Contact the operator to discuss their pipeline systems and areas of operation.

Vapors: Lighter than air and will generally rise and dissipate. May gather in a confined space and travel to a source of ignition.

Health Hazards: Will be easily ignited by heat, sparks or flames and will form explosive mixtures with air. Vapors may cause dizziness or asphyxiation without warning and may be toxic if inhaled at high concentrations. Contact with gas or liquefied gas may cause burns, severe injury and/or frostbite.

Public Awareness is an integral part of the safety program to provide emergency responders, customers, and those living and working near facilities with education on the natural gas system, the Public Awareness Program through Paradigm is in place to meet the overall goal of providing safe, reliable service to its customers via natural gas pipelines.

Qualified New York Mills Municipal Gas System Technicians are on call 24 hours a day, 7 days a week to respond to any natural gas emergency, dispatched technicians will use proper procedures to protect life, property, and the environment.
