



**SUNOCO TOLEDO TERMINAL**

Sunoco operates a 1.6 mile pipeline that receives gasoline and fuel oil from the Energy Transfer and Buckeye pipelines in the region. The facility has one breakout storage tank that is used for surge relief. Product is received by pipeline into aboveground storage tanks and then loaded onto trucks at the facility's truck loading rack.

**Sunoco, LP** is a leading energy infrastructure and fuel distribution master limited partnership operating in over 40 U.S. states, Puerto Rico, Europe, and Mexico. The Partnership's midstream operations include an extensive network

of approximately 14,000 miles of pipeline and over 100 terminals. 

