



ABOUT CLEVELAND-CLIFFS PLATE FINISHING-CONSHOHOCKEN

Conshohocken is a plate-finishing facility located on the Schuylkill River, adjacent to Philadelphia. The area is surrounded by highway and railroad systems that allow for excellent shipping access.

Cleveland-Cliffs supplies steel plate to the Conshohocken plant, which operates heat treatment, finishing and inspection facilities for steel plate finishing. Approximately 1 mile 8" distribution steel supplies the plant from the Enbridge point of delivery station.

WHAT DOES CLEVELAND-CLIFFS PLATE FINISHING-CONSHOHOCKEN PIPELINE DO IF A LEAK OCCURS?

To prepare for the event of a leak, pipeline companies regularly communicate, plan and train with local emergency responders. Upon the notification of an incident or leak the pipeline company will immediately dispatch trained personnel to assist emergency responders.

Pipeline operators and emergency responders are trained to protect life, property and facilities in the case of an emergency.

Pipeline operators will also take steps to minimize the amount of product that leaks out and to isolate the pipeline emergency.

MAINTAINING SAFETY AND INTEGRITY OF PIPELINES

Cleveland-Cliffs Plate Finishing-Conshohocken invests significant time and capital maintaining the quality and integrity of our pipeline systems. Personnel monitor the pipeline system and assess changes in pressure and flow. They can notify field personnel if there is a possibility of a leak. - Product:** Natural Gas
- Leak Type:** Gas
