ABOUT BRAZOS MIDSTREAM OPERATING III, LLC

Brazos Midstream Operating III, LLC is headquartered in Fort Worth TX, and is a natural gas gathering system spanning approximately 56 miles in Glasscock, Martin, Midland and Reagan Counties, TX. Brazos Midstream Operating employees and its pipeline system and facilities are located in Midland, TX. The Brazos Midstream Operating system is comprised of numerous gathering pipelines used to collect natural gas from production operations and transport to central points for delivery to associated markets. Compressor stations and pumping stations are located along transmission and gathering pipeline routes and help push energy products through the line. Brazos Midstream Operating monitors its pipeline system with a SCADA system that alarms employees when the system operates outside normal parameters. Field personnel patrol the system daily and respond to alarms 24 hours a day.

WHAT DOES BRAZOS MIDSTREAM OPERATING DO IF A LEAK OCCURS?

To prepare for the event of a leak, pipeline companies regularly communicate, plan and train with local emergency responders. Upon the notification of an incident or leak the pipeline company will immediately dispatch trained personnel to assist emergency responders.

Pipeline operators and emergency responders are trained to protect life, property, environment and facilities in the case of an emergency.



Pipeline operators will also take steps to minimize the amount of product that leaks out and to isolate the pipeline emergency. Brazos personnel will restrict the flow of product and implement other operating actions as needed to minimize the impact of the emergency. Public safety officials and other non-company personnel should not attempt to operate pipeline valves. Improper operation of pipeline valves can cause other accidents to occur.

MAINTAINING SAFETY AND INTEGRITY OF PIPELINES

Brazos Midstream Operating primary concern is safe and reliable delivery of product. According the National Transportation and Safety Board, pipelines are the safest and most economical way to transport products. We are committed to the safe operation of our pipelines in your community. Brazos Midstream Operating invests significant time and capital maintaining the quality and integrity of their pipeline systems.
