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ABOUT CONVERGE MIDSTREAM

Converge Midstream LLC owns and operates two 24-inch crude oil pipelines which cross through portions of Houston, South Houston, and Pasadena. The pipelines share a common right-of-way and travel approximately 18 miles between Converge’s Speed Junction facility in Pasadena and Converge’s Pierce Junction facility located near the Wildcat Golf Club in south-central Houston. Converge Midstream also operates an underground crude oil storage facility at Pierce Junction.

WHAT DOES CONVERGE MIDSTREAM LLC DO IF A LEAK OCCURS?

To prepare for the event of a leak, Converge Midstream regularly communicates, plans and trains with local emergency responders as well as with their own response and recovery contractors. Upon the identification of an incident or leak, Converge Midstream will immediately shutdown the pipeline and dispatch trained personnel and contractors to assist emergency responders. Converge Midstream will also take steps to minimize the amount of product that leaks out and isolate the pipeline emergency. Converge Midstream’s personnel and local emergency responders are trained to protect life, property and the environment in the case of an emergency.

MAINTAINING SAFETY AND INTEGRITY OF PIPELINES

Converge Midstream invests significant time and resources maintaining the operational and physical integrity of their pipeline systems. Control Center personnel continually monitor the pipeline system 24/7 and assess changes in pressures, flows, and other operating parameters to ensure safe operation. Converge also utilizes on-ground pipeline technicians to monitor the pipeline right-of-way and identify potential hazards before they pose a danger. Shut-off valves controlled remotely from the Control Center are

utilized when needed to stop and isolate a release, should one occur.

Converge Midstream maintains training, qualification, inspection, testing, operating, maintenance, corrosion control, community awareness, damage prevention, and risk and integrity management programs required by State and Federal regulations to ensure safe operation of its pipeline facilities.
