The Nuevo System includes gathering pipelines that aggregate field production into a Central Delivery Point located near Shiner, Texas with shell storage capacity of 300,000 barrels of oil. The Central Delivery Point is connected to the Nuevo Intermediate pipeline that is interconnected with a third-party transportation pipeline.

**WHAT DOES NUEVO DOS GATHERING AND TRANSPORTATION, LLC DO IF A LEAK OCCURS?**

To prepare for the event of a leak, pipeline operators regularly communicate, plan and train with local emergency responders. Upon the notification of an incident or leak, the pipeline operator will immediately dispatch trained personnel to assist emergency responders.

Pipeline operators and emergency responders are trained to protect life, property and facilities in the case of an emergency.

Pipeline operators will also take steps to minimize the amount of product that leaks out and to isolate the pipeline emergency.

**MAINTAINING SAFETY AND INTEGRITY OF PIPELINES**

Nuevo Dos Gathering and Transportation, LLC, invests significant time and capital maintaining the quality and integrity of the Nuevo System. Our comprehensive maintenance procedures are supplemented with integrity management plans that are reviewed by federal and state legislators and emergency first responders to make sure we are doing everything possible to prevent incidents along our pipelines. Operations personnel continually monitor the system and assess changes in pressure and flow. They notify field personnel if there is a possibility of a leak. Valves are utilized to isolate a leak.
