



ABOUT TRECORA PIPELINE

Trecora Pipeline is located in Silsbee, Texas. We monitor and control approximately 30 miles of Liquid Natural Gas Pipeline and six pipelines that carry Pentane, Hexane and Conosol 3.8 miles between the Trecora Plant and the Sales Loading Rack.

WHAT DOES TRECORA PIPELINE DO IF A LEAK OCCURS?

In case of a leak Trecora Pipeline puts life, environment, and property as our focus. We report to all federal, state and local authorities and assist in every form along the way, from training to response to clean-up.

PRODUCTS TRANSPORTED

Product: Natural Gas Liquid, Hexane, Pentane

Leak Type: Liquid

Vapors: Initially heavier than air, spread along ground and may travel to source of ignition and flash back. Product is colorless and tasteless.

Health Hazards: Will be easily ignited by heat, sparks or flames and will form explosive mixtures with air. Vapors may cause dizziness or asphyxiation without warning and may be toxic if inhaled at high concentrations. Contact with gas or liquefied gas may cause burns, severe injury and/or frostbite. Fire may produce irritating and/or toxic gases.

Product: Conosol

Leak Type: Liquid

Vapors: Vapors may travel to source of ignition and flash back. Most vapors are heavier than air and will spread along the ground and collect in low or confined areas.

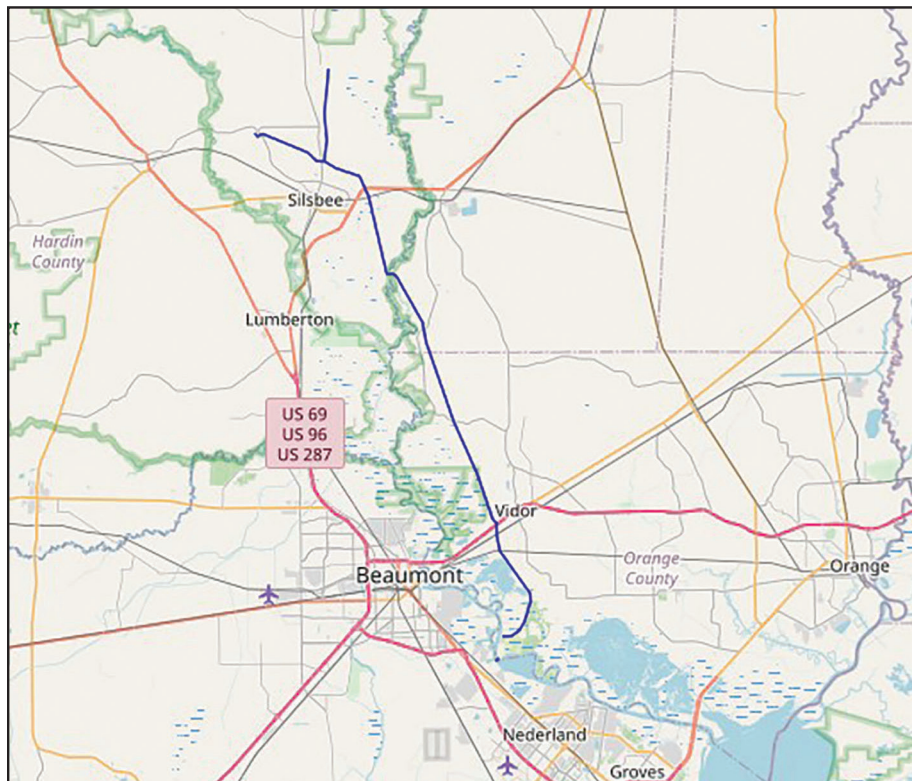
